CLASS 1- BRITISH DRIVING sponsored by Sue & James Smith

Single or multiple hitches to a British turnout 3yr and over any sex. Judged closer in line with the standards set by the British driving society (recognised as the worldwide authority on the driving horse or pony) we will be discouraging the use of side checks or over checks.

Young drivers to have a competent groom either to ride on board or be present in the ring. To ensure safe braking, breeching is advisable on all but the smallest and lightest carriage.

CLASS 2- AMERICAN DRIVING sponsored by Sue & James Smith

Single/multiple hitch to an American turnout, 3 yr. and over any sex. Judged closer in line with the standards set by the AMHA but do not need to be AMHA registered. To be judged on attitude, manners, performance, quality correctness and conformation. Horses should be on the bridle with a light contact maintained with relaxed head carriage. High action will be penalised. It is imperative that the horse gives the impression of being a pleasure to drive. A responsive mouth is paramount and all gaits to be performed with willingness ease cadence, balance and smoothness. Gaits required will be walk, pleasure trot, (relaxed and easy going) working trot (showing extension) horses will be required to stand quietly and back readily.

SHETLAND AFFILIATED TO SPSBS RING 1:

REGISTERED PONIES ONLY.

JUDGE: Mr L. GREGORY

Classes must be confined to SPS-BS registered ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the society or to foals eligible for registration. Three-year-old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the show

To enter a stallion in ANY class (in-hand or performance) at an affiliated show entire males aged 4 years and over must have an "S" number and have been successfully through either the SPS-BS Stallion assessment prior to 2006 or the current SPS-BS voluntary veterinary examination. Ridden stallions MUST display a stallion bridle badge. In-hand colts/stallions of two years old or over must be shown bitted and are advised to display a colt or stallion bridle badge, these are available to purchase from SPS-BS. There must be no colts or stallions in young handler's classes. Young handlers must be a minimum of three years of age on the day of the show. Children under 14 yrs. old may not show colts (excluding foals) or stallions in in-hand classes. Children aged under 12 years old on the day of their class may not show a stallion in ridden classes. In the interests of safety hardhats conforming to current British Safety standards must be worn, correctly secured, by all handlers aged 14 years or under in in-hand classes. For health and safety purposes judges and exhibitors must remain standing whilst in the ring when showing ponies. KNEELING IS NOT PERMITTED. Hard hats conforming to current British Safety standards must be worn, correctly secured, by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. Ridden and driven ponies must be 4 years old or over. In ridden classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.

Amateur & Youth must provide a copy of their current AMHA Amateur or Youth card. Both will be available at the show office. Applications are \$5 more when submitting at a show.

Gelding status must be on certificates.

AOTE (Amateur owned, trained and exhibited): The horse exhibited by the amateur must be trained, conditioned, groomed and shown ONLY by the amateur or a nonprofessional family member in all divisions entered.
